Did You Know?

The first tramway in Australia in 1861 was a horse-car line operating between Redfern Railway Station and Circular Quay Sydney, but it closed in 1866.

Steam trams began in Sydney in 1879 between the Railway Station and Hunter Street. In 1895 letter receivers were fitted to some trams and were cleared at the terminus but this service stopped in 1912 and receivers withdrawn. The following postmark was held at the GPO and a commemorative tram run was conducted over the last two routes - City to La Perouse and Maroubra Beach to Randwick and the covers were endorsed with cachets.



Although a posting receptacle was fixed to the commemoration tram for use only by NSW Tramways Historical Society members and Her Majesty the Queen, it fitted only 278 articles, and no special cachet was used to distinguish these cancels from the total cancelled. 15,820 ordinary and 33 registered covers (commemorative label) were postmarked.

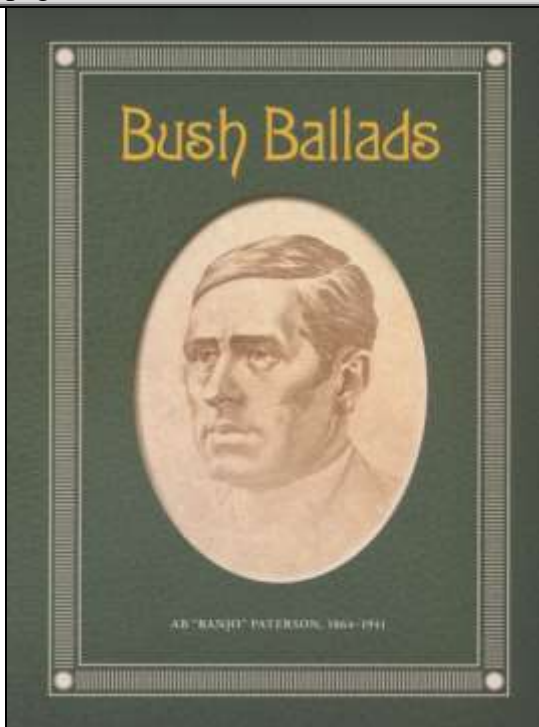

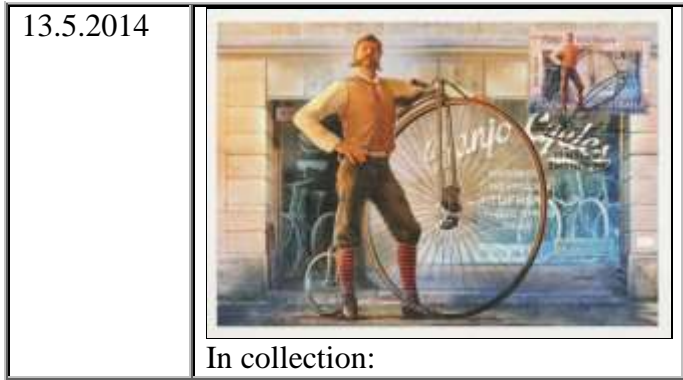

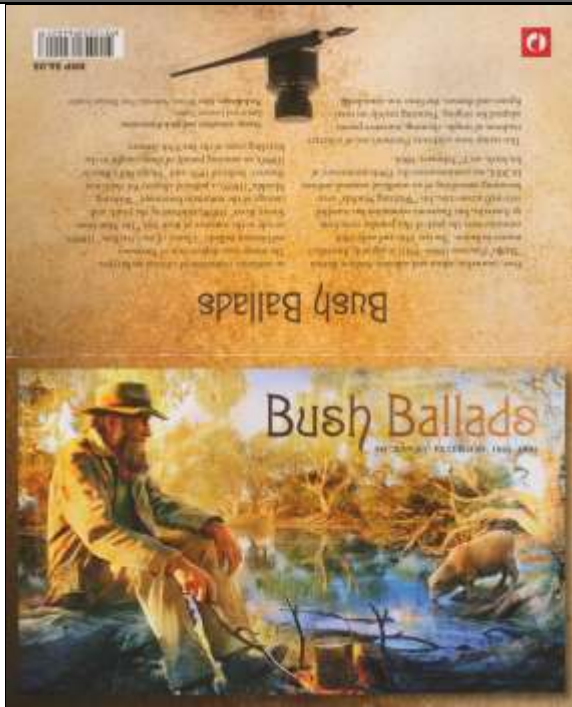
