

Another month gone by, but this month, not as many stamps, as compared to last month, have been issued by Australia Post. What Do I do with the excess money?

Parallel to issuing air letters or aerogrammes, as they are now called the Post Master General's Department granted licenses to private

organisation and in one known case to an individual a license to print air letters / aerogrammes. There were conditions attached. The main one is that in the indicum there is no stamp.
