Perforated stamps (OS) of South Australia

Introduction

After detecting unofficial use by staff of stamps the South Australian authorities decided that stamps had to be overprinted with a letter, or letters, indicating the department for which stamps were invoiced.

From 1 April 1868 overprints used red ink. Later in that year blue ink was used. Late in 1869 black ink was used for the overprints.

The system was cumbersome and in 1874 the Postmaster General recommended that stamps should be overprinted 'OS'. Existing stock were used up or handed to the Government Printer to mail the Government Gazette.





The six colonies, New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia, Tasmania, Victoria and Western Australia united to form the Commonwealth of Australia on 1 January 1901.

On 1 March 1901 control of the postal services passed to the federal administration. The first national postage due stamps appeared in July 1902, but it was not until January 1913 that postage stamps inscribed 'AUSTRALIA' were issued.
