Australia – Envelopes (1)

You may have noticed that most of the past bulletins have, more or less, contained articles about the fringes of stamp collecting, such as aerogrammes, Cinderella's, etc. Here starts another review of a fringe dweller, the humble envelope with stamps attached. Most collectors wash off the stamp and destroy the envelope. Too much volume to deal with., I suppose.

In the early years of the Australian stamp scene, first day covers were created by accident (more or less) as by design. Later, the cachet makers created nice looking collectable first day covers. Who are those cachet makers? Much information

is lost in time as those in the ‘know’ did not keep records, did not annotate their collections and in part, the cachet makers are to blame as they did not include a reference to their business. Royal and Wesley Cover Service are the rare exemptions.

I have attempted to compile a list, and, as usual, this is far from being complete.

Some cachet makers located outside of Australia are known and have provided First day Covers to collectors in Spain, Great Britain and France.

Some of the early cachets are advertising printed onto the envelope, such as Arnots did in 1930.

Please note that I refer to the Postmaster-General's Department (Post Office) in the individual annual listings from its beginning to 1975.

The Postmaster-General's Department of Australia was created in 1901 to take over all postal and telegraphic services within Australia from the states and administer them on a national basis. The Department was administered by the Postmaster-General.

In its first 25 years, the department grew from 6,000 to 10,000 offices and from 18,000 to 47,000 staff. Earnings grew from £2.4 million to £10 million per annum.

In mid-1975 the department was disaggregated into the Australian Telecommunications Commission (trading as Telecom Australia) and the Australian Postal Commission (trading as Australia Post). It also controlled radio and television broadcast licensing, which is now controlled by the Australian Communications and Media Authority. Telecom Australia changed its name to Telstra in 1995 and has since been privatized.


